

GRADES & END OF MARKING PERIOD #2

We are one-third of the way through the school year! The second marking period ends Friday, November 2nd.

Please make sure you are signed up for the Home Access Center (HAC) to view your child's grades. A grade of 70 or higher is considered passing. Students are expected to take advantage of tutorials and retake assessments they have failed. We offer ECO (Extra Classroom Opportunities) after school on Tuesday and Thursdays, as well as Saturday School on Saturday mornings for students to complete missing assignments.

ADVISORY

Students have Advisory daily from 9:28 to 9:48 AM. Advisory supports students in planning for the week, monitoring grades, receiving specialized lessons, and offering an opportunity for choice reading.

ROAR (Read Often & Relax) is a choice reading opportunity for all students and it aligns with our campus focus on literacy. All students are expected to have a book to read during ROAR. ROAR time is NOT the time for students to check books out from the library.



There will be opportunities for structured academic time (aka "study hall") at the end of the semester

LUNCH DELIVERIES

Food deliveries including, but not limited to, Doordash, Uber Eats, and pizza delivery are not allowed for students. Such deliveries are both a safety and health concern for students. Thank you for your support.

ID BADGES

In the month of October, our CAP (Counselors & AP) Center office has reissued over 600 ID badges!! Each student was issued one FREE ID at the start of the year. Students are EXPECTED to wear they ID badges all day, every day, everywhere (with the exception of PE/Athletics). ID badges should be worn above the waist on a lanyard around the neck or with a badge clip on their shirt. ID badges should be visible at all times. Students are EXPECTED to have an ID badge on to purchase food items in the cafeteria. If a student comes to school without an ID badge, they will be sent to the CAP Center to have another made. ID badges are \$3 each and may be charged to a student's account.
